Elderly Services

Services are geared towards assisting older adults to remain in their communities and homes, thus preventing premature institutionalization. Supervised elderly services range from music, art, exercise, wellness, health assessments, congregate meals, social activities and fieldtrips.

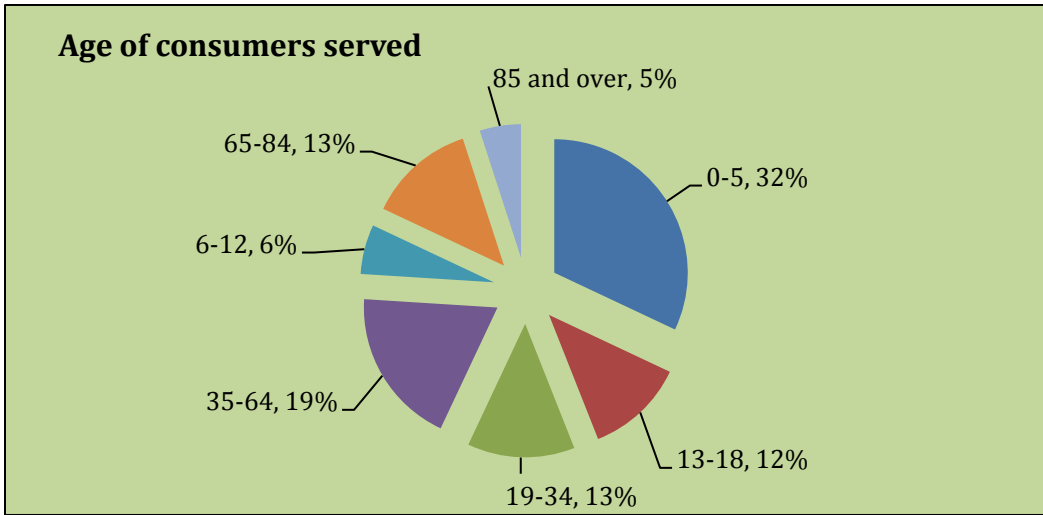
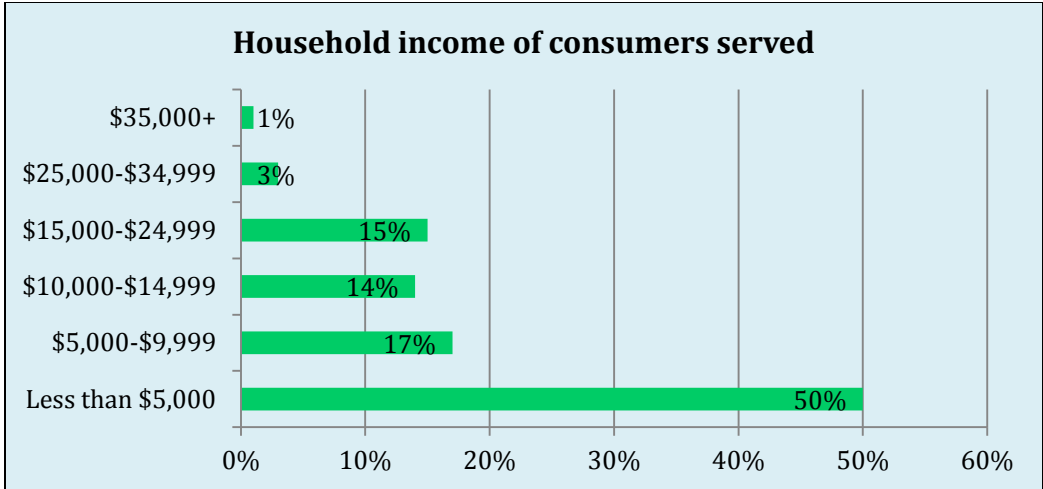
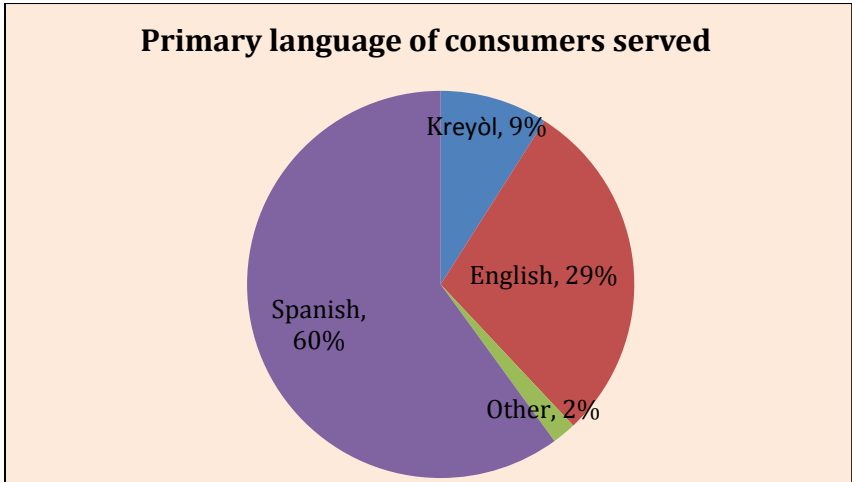
Summary

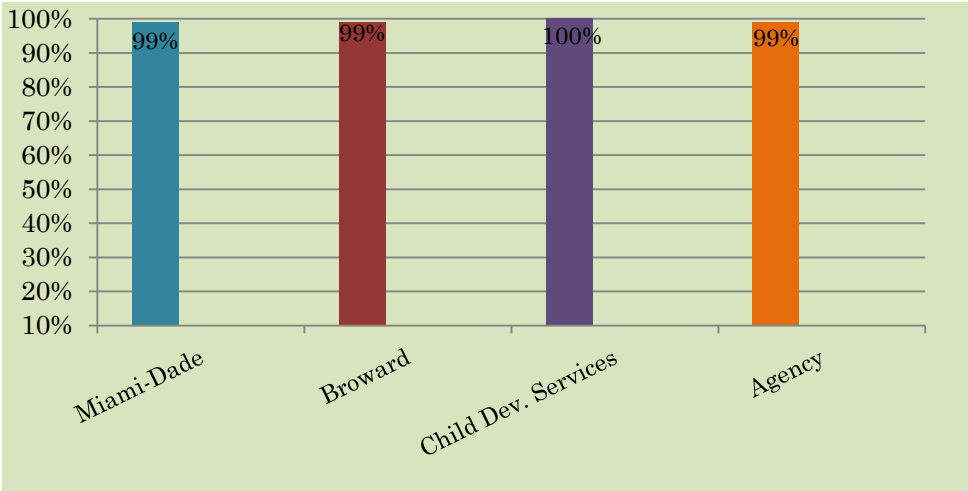


Consumer Demographics Information

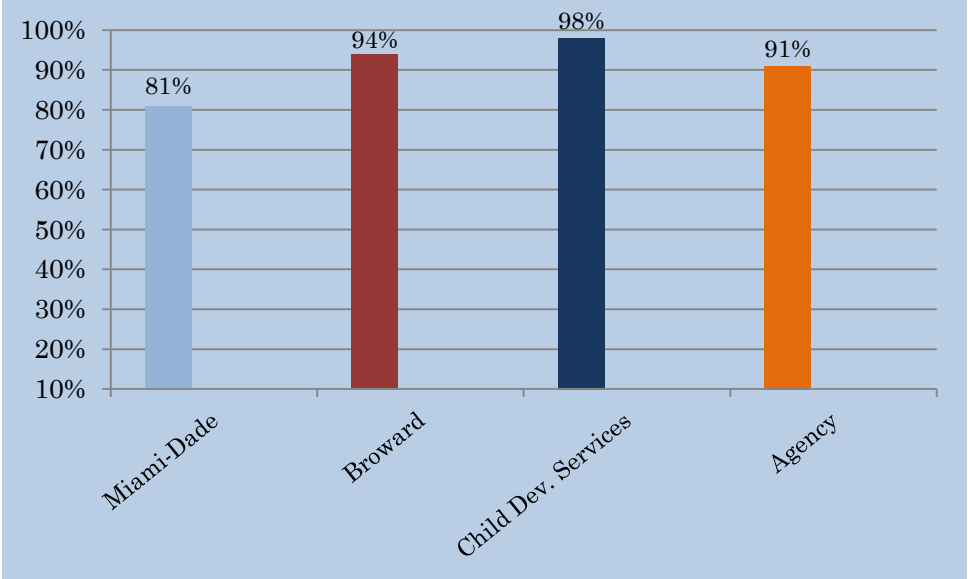


Consumer Satisfaction Survey Results
