Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Miami, Inc. is accepting proposals for the replacement and installation of one exterior stationary shade structure and the replacement of three shade fabrics.

Location of Center:

Good Shepherd Child Development Center
18601 SW 97th Avenue. Perrine, FL 33157

Scope of Services:

Shade 1

Removal and installation of shade fabric over paint and water play set approximately 12' X 12' color dark green (structure is not being replaced)

Responsible for all debris clean up.

Shade 2

Installation of one exterior stationary shade structure (approximately 35' X 30') with quick release shade cloth device.

Color of metal poles dark blue

Installation of shade fabric (color dark blue) approximately 35' X 30'

Responsible for all debris clean up.

Shade 3

Removal and installation of vinyl fabric attached to the building located at the playground exit door.

Replacement of fabric approximately 30' X 55' color dark blue (structure is not being replaced)

Responsible for all debris clean up.

Contractor is responsible for supplying all labor, material, security, storage, dumpster, plans, permits.

***Based on the inspection period, contractor may add any additional services needed to satisfactorily complete this project as part of the proposal**

- Required documents must be submitted with proposal.
